Dear Jerry Vogeler:

Enclosed is the reporting form for filing the year-end campaign finance report due in this office by 5:00 p.m. on February 1, 2011. Postmarked reports that are received after the filing deadline do not meet the filing requirement. **Campaign finance law establishes a \$50 per day administrative penalty for late filing.** The **committee treasurer** is the only person who can sign this report.

The report must contain all receipts and expenditures from the cutoff date of your last report through December 31st. Your last report filed on 10/21/2010 indicated a balance of \$38.27. This will be the balance on hand with which you must start this report. If you currently do not have a balance from a previous report, you must start this report with a \$0 balance. You are still required to file a year-end report even if your committee did not receive or spend any money during 2010.

If you had outstanding obligations listed on your last report these must also be accounted for. Your outstanding obligations were reported as:

Also, if your organization is no longer involved in receiving and expending money, please indicate on this report how all your funds have been disbursed, how your debts have been paid and indicate on the cover page that this is a termination report.
