Figure 1a. Length frequency of angler-harvested Smallmouth Bass measured by the creel clerk during creel surveys on Oahe.

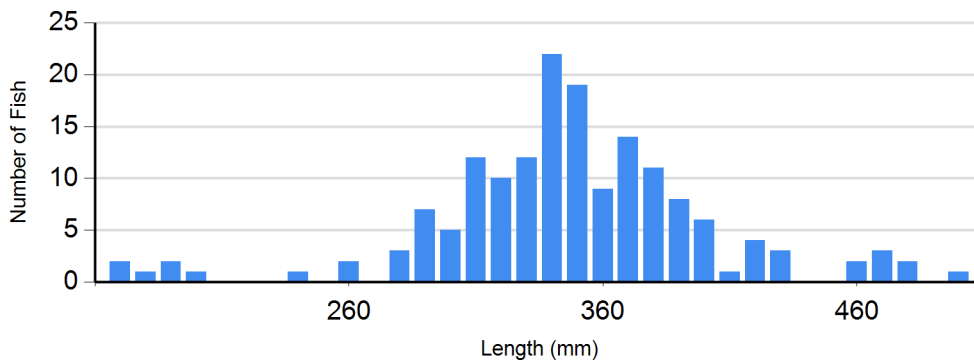
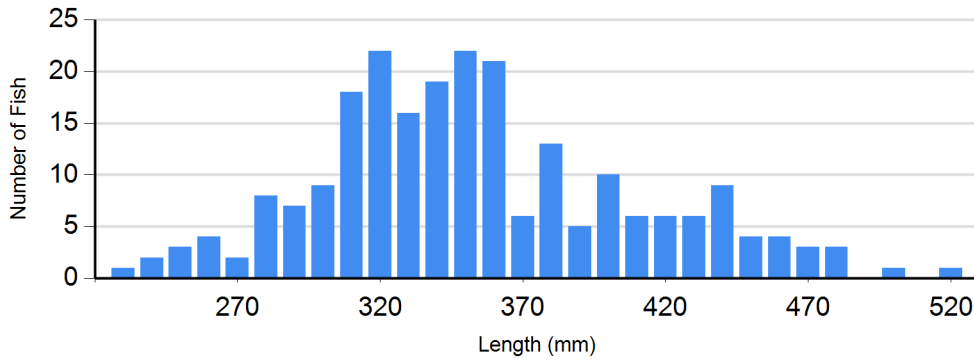


Figure 1b. Length frequency of angler-harvested Walleye measured by the creel clerk during creel surveys on Oahe.

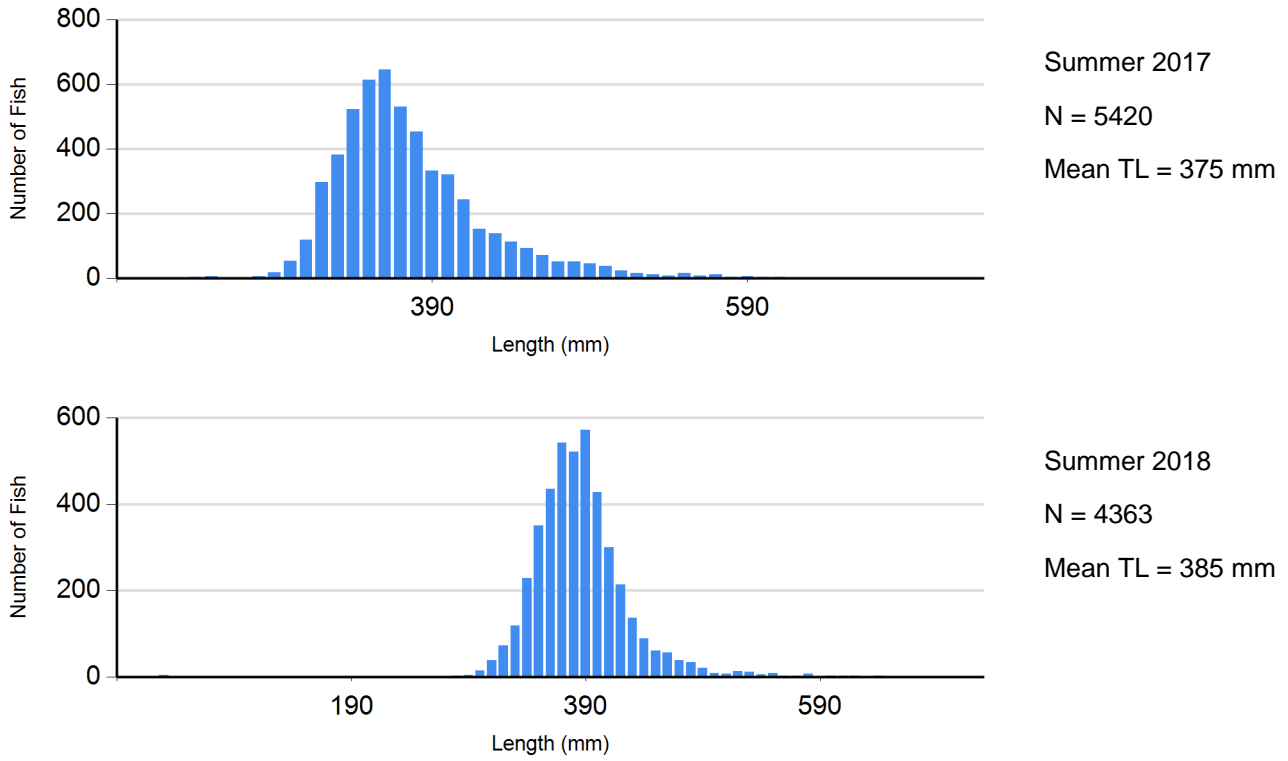


Figure 2. South Dakota county of residence for winter and summer resident anglers fishing Oahe, South Dakota between May 2017 and July 2018.

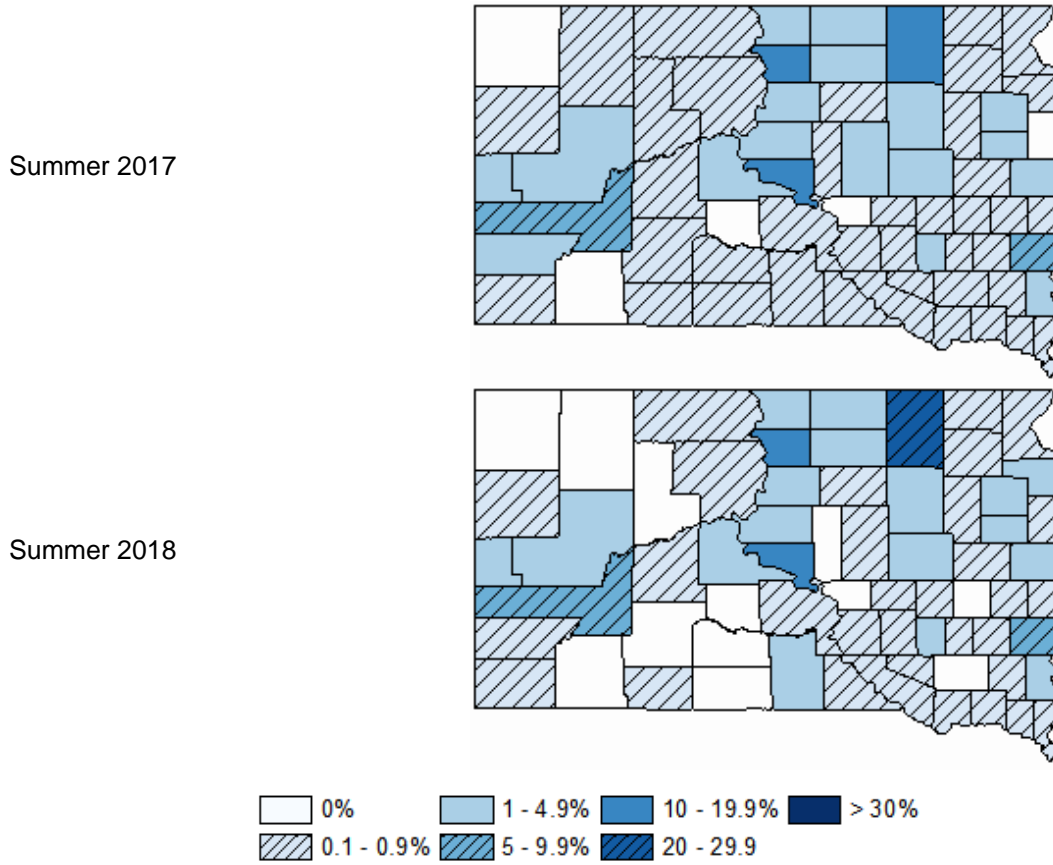
