Figure 1a. Length frequency of angler-harvested Rainbow Trout measured by the creel clerk during creel surveys on Sheridan.




Figure 2. South Dakota county of residence for winter and summer resident anglers fishing Sheridan, South Dakota between May 2018 and July 2018.


