Figure 1a. Length frequency of angler-harvested Walleye measured by the creel clerk during creel surveys on Oahe Upper.





Figure 2. South Dakota county of residence for winter and summer resident anglers fishing Oahe Upper, South Dakota between May 2019 and July 2019.
