Except for the lowest bidder on the project, all guarantees will be returned immediately following the receipt and checking of all bids.

The successful bidder will furnish a performance bond in a sum equal to the full amount of the contract, prior to contract award. 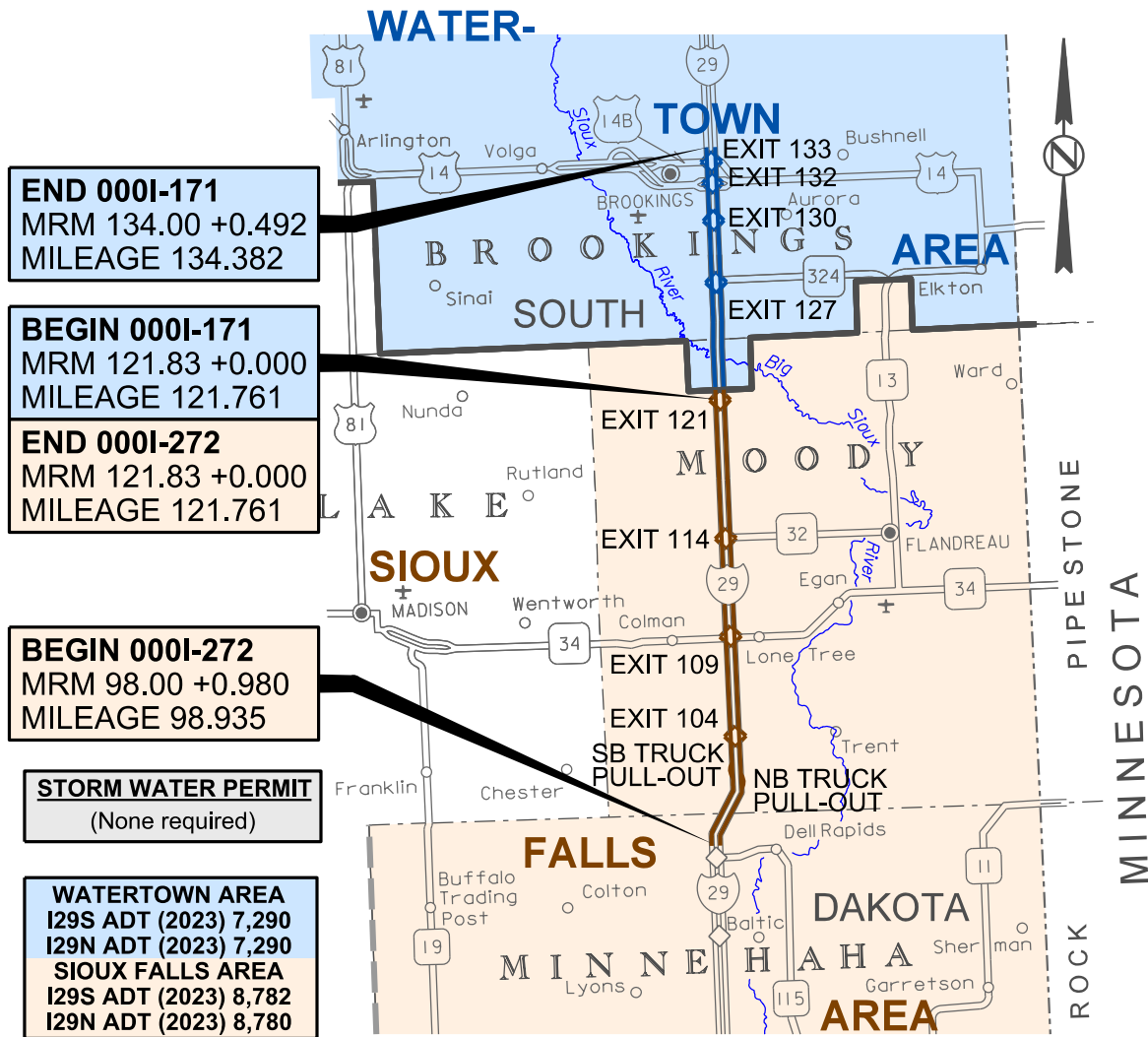
