The South Dakota Department of Transportation (SDDOT), Pierre Region Office – Bldg. A, 104 S. Garfield, Pierre, South Dakota 57501, desires to solicit bids for Pick Up of Road Killed Deer on:

US 14 from MRM 203.4 to MRM 263.2 (West of Ft. Pierre to Harrold, SD)

SD 34 from MRM 211.6 to MRM 257.0 (From Pierre to Jct. of SD34 and SD47)

US 83S from MRM 87.2 to MRM 119.5 (From Ft. Pierre to I-90)

US 83N from MRM 138.7 to MRM 191.2 (From Pierre to Jct. of US 83 & SD 20)

SD 1804 from MRM 250.5 to MRM 303.3 (From Jct. of US 14 - N to Jct. at US 212)

US 212 from MRM 208.1 to MRM 244.9 (Potter County)

SD 1806 from MRM 138.45 to MRM 221.05 (Stanley/Lyman County)

Sealed bids for this work will be accepted until **2:00 p.m. (CDT) on June 21, 2012**, and will be opened at that time in the Pierre Region Office – Bldg. A. Bids MUST be received in an envelope with "Road Kill Deer – Pierre Area" written on the outside.

There are no bonding requirements for this contract; however, a Certificate of Commercial Liability Insurance will be required of the successful bidder. Please refer to page 2, note No.11 in the Project Specifications.

The Department of Transportation hereby notifies all bidders that it will affirmatively ensure that in any contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement, minority business enterprises will be afforded full opportunity to submit bids in response to this invitation and will not be discriminated against on grounds of race, color, sex, religion or national origin in consideration of an award.

The Department of Transportation reserves the right to reject any and all bids. No faxed bids will be accepted.

The Contractor's signature on the DOT-123 form MUST be notarized to constitute a legal bid.

ROAD-KILLED DEER PROJECT SPECIFICATIONS

The South Dakota Department of Transportation and the South Dakota Department of Game, Fish and Parks, hereafter referred to as the STATE, are desirous of having road-killed deer promptly removed from the public right of way and disposed of properly.

The STATE agrees to:


- 1. The South Dakota Department of Transportation will communicate the location of known road-killed deer, including the highway number, county, milepost (MRM); or an adequate description of the location from a known point.
- 2. Provide the State Highway Patrol, DOT vehicles and Game, Fish & Parks with highly visible, wire staff, plastic flags that will be used to mark road-killed deer locations. These flags are to mark locations of road-killed deer not easily seen.
- 3. Provide the Contractor with a supply of road-killed deer reporting forms, copy attached.
- 4. The Department of Transportation will compensate the Contractor monthly, at the contract unit price, for each deer picked up and disposed of properly. A contact person and telephone number will be provided to answer any payment questions or problems.
- 5. The Department of Transportation will provide the Contractor with two magnetic signs to be used on the vehicle used to pick up deer. These signs will read "Deer Disposal Contractor". The Contractor will return these signs to the Department of Transportation, in good condition, at the end of the contract. If the magnetic signs are damaged the Contractor will supply the Department of Transportation with replacement signs at no cost to the Department of Transportation.

The CONTRACTOR agrees to:

- 1. Pick up of road-killed deer will be no less frequent than Monday, Wednesday and Friday after being contacted by the SDDOT or SD Game, Fish & Parks. Deer killed in the afternoon on Friday may be picked up on the Monday pickup.
- 2. Provide the Department of Transportation with the name of a contact person along with a telephone number, cell phone number and either an e-mail address or a fax number.
- 3. Dispatch properly equipped vehicles with qualified drivers to pick up the reported deer kill, unless circumstances intervene such as illness or holidays. In such circumstances, the Contactor shall promptly notify the Department of Transportation so that other arrangements can be made. The Contractor will work with the Department of Transportation to resolve any such problems.
- 4. Pick up all road killed deer located within the public highway right-of-way on routes as listed on the contract, regardless if reported or not. Contractor will notify the Department of Transportation of the pick-up of road-killed deer that have not been reported.
- 5. Advise the Department of Transportation within twenty-four (24) hours of the discovery of unsafe circumstances at any road-kill site that prevents the Contractor from reasonably accomplishing the pick up of a road-killed deer.

- 6. Complete the State furnished Road-Killed Deer Report forms and submit them at the end of each month for payment. Forms shall be submitted to the Department of Transportation, Pierre Area Office, 104 S. Garfield, Building A, Pierre, SD 57501. The completed forms will include the Highway number, MRM location, County, Date Notified and Date Picked Up, the species of deer and the sex of the deer.
- 7. The Contractor will dispose of any plastic flags that have marked deer locations, along with the road-killed deer.
- 8. Maintain, in good working condition at all times, an amber warning light, strobe or rotating light, approved by the Department of Transportation. The amber light is to be placed on the upper rear or cab of each vehicle used under this contract. The amber light is to be operating and will promote safety while loading road-killed deer, traveling at speeds less than 40 mph, or otherwise occupying the right of way in performing services under this contract. This light shall be a minimum of 55 watt halogen bulb for the rotating light.
- 9. The Contractor shall park his vehicle only on the shoulder of the roadway or on a field approach so as to keep all traffic lanes open.
- 10. The Contractor shall wear highly visible clothing or safety vests when working near traffic. Safety vests will need to meet ANSI-107-2004 Class 2 Standards.
- 11. Purchase and maintain commercial liability insurance for the duration of the Contract to cover property damage or bodily injury as imposed by law. This liability insurance shall contain a minimum coverage amount of \$500,000.00. This insurance shall cover all operations under the contract, whether performed by the Contractor or a subcontractor. (This liability insurance is above and beyond normal liability insurance typically associated with homeowners, automobile, etc. The Bidder is strongly encouraged to contact an insurance company prior to submitting bids for this contract to obtain quotes for this insurance.)
- 12. Worker's Compensation Insurance shall meet the requirement of the South Dakota Workmen's Compensation Law.
- 13. Prior to commencing work, the Contractor shall furnish certificates of liability insurance in the amount of \$500,000.00. The Contractor may not change carrier coverage unless the Department of Transportation, Pierre Area Office, has been given thirty (30) days written notice.
- 14. The Contractor will dispose of each deer properly in accordance with all State laws, regulations, and County/City ordinances. Disposal regulations may be obtained from Andy Lindbloom with the Game, Fish and Parks Services. The telephone number is (605) 223-7709.
- 15. Contractor agrees to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.
- 16. The Contractor is NOT entitled to harvest any part(s) from any road-killed deer. The entire carcass must be disposed of.
- 17. Provide services as defined and described above within the Pierre Area as shown on the enclosed map.
- 18. Indemnify, save and hold harmless, the Department and all its employees and agents from any and all claims, demands, actions or causes of actions of the work provided for under this contract, whether or not the Contractor is itself negligent or otherwise culpable.
