## What is CSHS - Health KiCC?

Children's Special Health Services (CSHS) - Health KiCC (Better Health for Kids with Chronic Conditions), is a program, funded through federal and state monies, that provides financial assistance for procedures, treatments, medications and travel reimbursement for children with chronic health conditions. Care coordination services are also available upon request.

## How we help...

- CSHS - Health KiCC will cover 100% of eligible covered expenses. If you are eligible, the program will cover the entire cost of the coverable services after other 3rd party sources are billed.
- Mileage Reimbursement is available for medical appointments specific to the coverable condition.
- Care coordination is available. At your request, a care coordinator can assist you in explaining all of the services your child may need. This could include things like connecting to other resources; identifying the best options for your particular situation or needs; and helping to prepare your child for transitions at daycare, school and into adulthood.

## Who is eligible?

To be eligible for CSHS - Health KiCC, a child must:

- Be a resident of South Dakota
- Be under 21 years of age
- Have a chronic medical condition covered by CSHS - Health KiCC
- Meet financial guidelines

You will need to complete the application; provide proof of your current income; and have a medical provider document your child's medical condition.

Your child must meet all program eligibility requirements to qualify.
